

Course Terms & Conditions

These terms apply to all piercing courses and masterclasses organised by Yr Piercing.

Registration

A course place is reserved after payment of the required deposit.

During registration, the participant must select the correct course and available session. The booking confirmation will be sent by email.

Registrations close one month before the course start date. Requests received after this deadline may be transferred to the next available session.

Course Price and Deposit

The deposit is deducted from the total course price.

The remaining balance must be paid by the deadline stated on the course page or payment request. Failure to pay the balance on time may result in cancellation of the reservation.

Any optional professional piercing kit is purchased separately unless explicitly included in the course description.

Statutory Cooling-Off Period

Consumers who register online generally have a statutory cooling-off period of 14 days from the date the booking confirmation is received.

During this period, the participant may cancel the registration without giving a reason and receive a refund of the deposit.

The right of withdrawal may be limited when the participant expressly requests the course or related services to begin during the cooling-off period, in accordance with applicable Dutch consumer law.

Cancellation by the Participant

Cancellations must be submitted in writing by email.

After the statutory cooling-off period, Yr Piercing may deduct reasonable costs already incurred in connection with the registration. These may include administrative work, ordered or prepared study materials, reserved facilities or other non-recoverable costs.

Any remaining amount will be refunded where applicable.

Failure to attend the course without prior written cancellation is treated as non-attendance. Reasonable costs already incurred and services already provided may be charged.

Transfer to Another Session

Where possible, Yr Piercing may allow a participant to transfer the booking to a later course session.

Transfers depend on availability and are not automatically guaranteed. Any costs already incurred for personalised materials or special orders may still be charged.

Cancellation or Rescheduling by Yr Piercing

Yr Piercing may reschedule or cancel a course because of insufficient enrolment, illness, safety concerns, unavailable models or circumstances beyond reasonable control.

When Ýr Piercing cancels a course, the participant may choose between:

- transferring the full payment to a new available date; or
- receiving a refund of the amount paid.

Ýr Piercing is not responsible for indirect expenses such as travel, accommodation or loss of income.

Theory and Practical Training

Theory and practical training are organised as separate parts of the course.

Practical procedures depend on suitable model availability, anatomy, safety and the professional judgement of the instructor. Participation in a course does not guarantee that every listed procedure can be performed by every participant.

The instructor may stop or refuse a practical procedure when it cannot be performed safely.

Study Materials

The course includes the theoretical study materials described on the relevant course page.

Study materials are intended exclusively for the registered participant. They may not be copied, resold, published, uploaded or distributed without written permission from Ýr Piercing.

Optional Piercing Kits

Optional piercing kits may be offered separately.

The exact contents and price of each kit will be stated before purchase. Sterile, sealed or hygiene-sensitive products cannot be returned after opening, except where statutory consumer rights require otherwise.

Entry Requirements and Conduct

Participants must be at least 18 years old unless explicitly stated otherwise.

Advanced courses may require previous training or demonstrable piercing experience.

Participants must follow all hygiene, safety and professional instructions. Ýr Piercing may exclude a participant whose behaviour creates a safety risk or seriously disrupts the course.

Certificate of Participation

Participants who complete the required theory and practical course components receive a certificate of participation.

The certificate confirms participation in the course. It is not a government-recognised diploma, professional licence or GGD certification.

The training takes place in a studio with a valid GGD permit. The permit applies to the studio and its hygiene procedures, not to the course certificate.

Professional Responsibility

The course provides education, supervised practice and professional guidance.

Completion of a course does not automatically mean that a participant is ready to work independently or open a piercing studio. Participants remain responsible for continuing their training, complying with local regulations and working within their own competence.

Personal Data and Photography

Personal data is processed for registration, payment, course administration and communication in accordance with the Ýr Piercing privacy policy.

Photographs or videos showing identifiable participants will only be used for promotional purposes with their permission.

Complaints and Applicable Law

Complaints should be submitted in writing so that Ýr Piercing has a reasonable opportunity to resolve the matter.

These terms are governed by Dutch law. Mandatory consumer rights remain fully applicable.
